

Dear Parents,

Your child has received a log in to 'Bug Club.' Bug Club is a wonderful resource which allows children to read books at their level, at home, on a tablet, computer, phone or laptop. Children will have 5 books to read and as they read the books they will answer questions about the book they are reading. Teachers will continue to add new books so that your child always has books to read. Teacher will be able to see how well children are doing by receiving information about the questions they answer. Children also get to collect stickers and coins along the way!

How to use Bug Club

- Log in using the log in details your child has received. You will get to a page that looks this

Once your child has read a book it will go into 'My Library' where they will be able to read it again at any time.

'My stuff' is the area where your child will be able to access his/her reading books. There will always be 5 books for them to choose from and they will have questions to answer.

When your child has finished all the quiz questions in a book, your child will earn 'ActiveLearn Coins'. By reading more books, your child will earn enough coins to 'buy' a reward in one of the many reward schemes.




The 'Grown – ups' part of the website is designed to support parents. This is an area where parents will find important information to help support your children at home.

- Once children have logged in they will have 5 books to choose from to read. Children can choose any of these five books, in any order.



When children are reading their books they will come across a little bug when they have questions to answer. Children need to click on the bug and read the question and try their best to answer it. They will have three chances to get the answer correct.

Once they have answered the question, the little bug's eyes will close and that means the question is complete.

Teachers will receive information about the questions your child has answered and how many attempts it took them to get to the correct answer.

You will also notice that there will be a 'Read to me' function. This allows children to sit and listen to the story being told.
